

FOXBOROUGH STAFF/PARENT GUIDELINES
What to do if student/staff is a close contact or has recently traveled?

A household member is sick with **NO known close contact of a positive case**

A household member is a close contact

A household member is waiting for test results

A household member recently traveled outside of the lower risk states

Student/ Staff can attend school as long as **ASYMPTOMATIC**, no known close contact of **POSITIVE** case, and continue to monitor for **ANY** symptoms
 *Consult with building nurse with any questions/concerns

CALL HEALTHCARE PROVIDER & SCHOOL NURSE
START QUARANTINE IMMEDIATELY

Student/staff is a close contact of a **POSITIVE** case

A household member tested **POSITIVE** for COVID-19

*Student/Staff recently traveled outside of the lower risk states

Obtain PCR test within 72 hours of returning to MA or quarantine per travel order guidelines. Send results to school nurse

POSITIVE COVID TEST

STRICT ISOLATION
 Return to school **AFTER 10 days of isolation AND improved symptoms AND fever free for 24 hours without fever reducing medications**

RETURN TO SCHOOL CRITERIA
UPDATED QUARANTINE GUIDELINES

OPTIONS:
7 days of strict quarantine: Release on Day 8 IF **negative** test taken Day 5 or later, no symptoms up to that point AND continues to CLOSELY monitor symptoms through day 14
10 days of strict quarantine: Release on Day 11 IF no symptoms up to that point AND continues to CLOSELY monitor symptoms through day 14. **Testing not done.**
14 days of strict quarantine: Release on Day 15 IF experienced ANY symptoms during the quarantine period EVEN with a negative test or the individual indicates they are unwilling or unable to closely monitor for symptoms.
 *SEND ALL RESULTS TO THE SCHOOL NURSE TO BE CLEARED TO RETURN
